



Patent Prosecution - An Inside Look

Abstract: Many people are often intimidated by the process of obtaining a patent, and sometimes may not understand what is going on, even when they have engaged a patent attorney. This seminar will give you a basic inside look of the inner workings of the patent process, from filing to issuance, along with enforcement issues for both domestic and foreign patents.
